Tosti Prosecco 75cl Sparkling - Italy (36) A fine, soft mousse and just a subtle hint of sweetness make this a great example of our favourite bubbles. Also available in 20cl bottles. £8.50	£27

Hattingley Valley Classic Reserve NV - England (37) Elegant and svelte, with a delicate nose of hedgerow flowers and vibrant green fruit. A characteristic toasty flavour comes through on a palate defined by crisp acidity and fine mousse.	£58
Gobillard Brut Grande Réserve Premier Cru Champagne - France (38) The palate is elegant with a toasty mousse and mineral like acidity. This coasts across the palate slowly revealing nectarine, warm bread, acacia and Manuka honey characters.

## Whites

## Cuma Organic Torrontes - Argentina (11) £30 Dry with stone and orchard fruits with floral and honeyed layers.

## McPherson Sunburnt Chardonnay - Australia (13)

£29

A rich and textural wine displaying lovely aromas of tropical fruits with a hint of apple and spice. Lovely light oak balances and completes the picture.

Les Celliers de Cérès Sancerre Le Petit Broux 2022 - France - Loire (1) £49 Good concentration of green fruits and crisp citrus flavours with a racy, mineral streak and refreshingly clean finish. An eminently drinkable Sauvignon.

## Olivier Tricon Chablis 2019 - France - Burgundy (2)

£55

Keen, refreshing and dry this is a classic performance of cool climate Chardonnay. Apples, pears and a certain steeliness on the nose move to a refined and subtle palate. Bracing acidity with mineral notes, green orchard fruits and just a hint of lemon pith on the finish.

#### **Viognier - France - Languedoc (9)**

£26

A summer garden filled with peaches, apricots and honeyblossom. The palate has a supple richness and is filled with stone fruits and blossoms. Dry, uplifting and vibrant.

## Weingut Tesch Riesling Queen of Whites - Germany (10)

£32

Queen's pawn to lemon and lime and rook to king's minerals and oranges. Knights lead oranges and acacia flowers into a flavour battle with tasty stone fruits. Think you know German Riesling? Think again. Check mate.

# Yealands Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc - NZ - Marlborough (8) £33 Whilst this has the characteristic burst of passion fruit, kiwi and melon, it's more complex and supple than the average NZ SB. Layers of blackcurrant leaf, lime and mandarin all play around on the crisply refreshing palate and the finish goes on for days.

## Quinta da Lixa Flowers Vinho Verde - Portugal (5)

£24

Fruity, floral notes, fresh and well balanced. The nose is aromatic green apple, melon and white peach. The palate is balanced, smooth with a generous texture and a touch of petulance. White peach, apples and tangerine on the palate leading to a long, crisp finish.

## Ramon Bilbao Albarino - Spain (4)

£32

A classic nose of waxed lemons, green apples and just a hint of passionfruit. The palate moves to something slightly tropical but grounded with nectarine, peach and white flowers. A bracing acidity gives a hint of the sea with a crunchy citrus fruit finish.

# Trapiche Estación 1883 Cabernet Franc - Argentina (29) £31 Herbal, floral, forest fruit aromas. Palate is vibrant with darker fruit and spicy notes at the fore, developing to a lingering rich finish with hints of coffee.

## d'Arenberg The Footbolt Shiraz - Australia (26)

£34

A lifted, aromatic nose with luscious plum and red berry aromas. The palate is soft and cuddly and concludes with some firm tannin and acidity.

## Ventopuro Estelar Carmenere - Chile (27)

£34

Dark cherry, plum, and bramble fruit explode like a supernova from the nose before an entire galaxy's worth of smoke, vanilla, cedar, and warm spices flood the senses. Big, rich, and characterful; it's a true reflection of just how good Carmenere can be.

#### Les Mougeottes Pinot Noir IGP P d'Oc - France (17)

£27

The darker, richer side of Pinot Noir. With enough ripeness, the Noir can give dark cherry and plum characters as well as some violet notes. This has a splash of fresh vanilla smoke to add an extra frissant to proceedings.

#### Château St Marie Bordeaux - France (18)

£31

Beautifully vibrant, just-picked berry fruit aromas and flavours, with a hint of aromatic spice and vanilla, that gives it a definite Bordeaux sense of place. Clean, refreshing and oh so silky smooth.

## Joseph Drouhin Givry 2019 - France - Burgundy (34)

£60

Drouhin makes a taut and precise style of wine that always has a certain generosity. Here ripe cherries, wild strawberries and forest fruits are to the fore, there's a hint of something earthy and minerally but it's downplayed to allow the fruit to shine.

## Enfant Terrible Cotes Du Rhone Rouge - France (28)

£28

A red fruit and supple spice driven Rhone. Raspberries and plums are surrounded by sweet smoke and pepper spice. Soft, integrated tannins add a touch of complexity as vanilla and roasting meat notes emerge.

## Château Durfort-Vivens Margaux 2016 - France - Bordeaux (33)

£90

A classic Margaux perfume rides over the top of blackcurrant, blackberry and fine smoky cedar flavours. There is a fleshiness in the fruit but the structure is taut and elegant. Fine vanilla, dark cherry and plum and a note of minerality all lead this elegant and complex palate.

## Reds continued...

## Château Bel-Air Puisseguin St Emilion - France - Bordeaux (30)

£42

The nose is redolent with plums, damsons, dark cherry, and a healthy wallop of blackcurrant fruit. The finely balanced palate is supported by melt in the mouth tannins, dark fruit, and a wonderful freshness.

## Da Vinci Chianti Riserva - Italy - Tuscany (16)

£34

Quintessential Chianti, a blend of cherries and loamy earth, prettily perfumed by violets.

#### Boheme Primitivo Salento - Italy (23)

£25

Rich aromas of plum and black cherry with spicy notes of cracked black pepper. A charming, well balanced wine with a velvety texture and intense black forest and damson fruits.

## Journey Collection Rioja Reserva - Spain - Rioja (31)

£37

Rioja Reserva should be filled with notes of earth, roasted coffee, dark chocolate, raspberries and plums. This does all of that and more. Finely balanced oak adds flavours of coconut, cocoa and vanilla whilst further notes of blackberry, black plum and damson fill the palate.

## Chateau Ste. Michelle Columbia Valley Syrah 2018 - USA (32)

£45

An approachable and fruit-forward Syrah with an inviting velvety texture, brimming with flavours of red fruit and crushed dark berries.

## Dessert Wines

Lucien Lurton Garonelles Sauternes - France (41)

(50ml) £4.50 (100ml) £8.00 (Bottle 37.5cl) £27

A core of marmalade and oranges is surrounded by peach, apricot, pineapple and mango. Luscious notes of honey, blossom, sweet yellow fruits and just a touch of caramel.

Principe de Viana Chardonnay - Spain (42) (50ml) £3 (100ml) £5.00 (Bottle 50cl) £20 Ripe juicy Chardonnay fermented and aged for three months in a mixture of American and French oak. Nose has hints of orange blossom and some elegant notes of toast and cream from the oak ageing.

## Port

Cockburns Fine Ruby Port - Portugal (44) (50ml) £3.20 (100ml) £6.00 (Bottle 75cl) £38 A fine port wine from hand-picked grapes sure to delight any time, any place.

## Ramos Pinto Collector Reserva - Portugal (45)

(50ml) £4.20 (100ml) £8.00 (Bottle 75cl) £52

Reserva Collector is a powerful and earthy 5 year old blend port. Firm and full of blackberry fruits on the palate with silky tannins. Awarded Silver Medal at Decanter World Wine Awards 2006.

## Quinta Do Crasto Vintage Port - Portugal (47)

£70

Excellent aroma expression and concentration, showing fresh berry fruit and soft hints of spice.

## Bin Ends

## Chablis Louis Moreau Chardonnay 2019 (Bin End) (02)

£34

Notes of green and yellow apple join zesty lemon hints on this wine's appetising nose. The palate carries that same fruitiness, marked by both full ripeness and aromatic freshness.

## Domaine Daulny Sancerre 2020 (Bin End) (01)

£39

A stunning example of classic Sauvignon Blanc. Pure, crisp grassy fruit on the nose with hints of blackcurrant leaf. Lean, racy and concentrated on the palate with complex flavours of citrus and mineral with a dry finish typical of this varietal.

## Moselland Riesling Kabinett 2020 (Bin End) (10)

£20

A fragrant, fresh wine with the typical Riesling fruity flavours of lime and green apple. The characteristic mineral aromas and a refreshing crispness make it easy to enjoy.
