Champagne & Sparkling

Le Contesse Prosecco 75cl Sparkling - Italy (36) £27

A sparkling straw yellow wine fruity and floral - nicely balanced

Also available in 20cl bottles. £8.50

Le Contesse Prosecco Rosé 75cl Sparkling - Italy (35) £29

Pink Prosecco - because why not! Fruity and delicate.

Veuve Ambal Cremant Grand Cuvee - France (40) £39

Zesty Fizz, a great alternative to champagne, produced in the same way just down the road from Champagne, a Brook House family favourite.

Hattingley Valley Classic Reserve NV - England (37) £60

Elegant and svelte, with a delicate nose of hedgerow flowers and vibrant green fruit. A characteristic toasty flavour comes through on a palate defined by crisp acidity and fine mousse.

Gobillard Brut Grande Réserve Premier Cru Champagne - France (38) £65

The palate is elegant with a toasty mousse and mineral like acidity. This coats across the palate slowly revealing nectarine, warm bread, acacia and Manuka honey characters.

Laurent Perrier NV Champagne - France (39) £90

Delicate and fresh aromas with good complexity. Notes of citrus and peach. Fresh and supple on the palate with rounded and expressive fruit flavours.

Whites

Les Celliers de Cérès Sancerre Le Petit Broux 2022/3- France - Loire (1) £49

Good concentration of green fruits and crisp citrus flavours with a racy, mineral streak and refreshingly clean finish. An eminently drinkable Sauvignon.

Olivier Tricon Chablis 2023 - France - Burgundy (2) £55

Keen, refreshing and dry this is a classic performance of cool climate Chardonnay. Apples, pears and a certain steeliness on the nose move to a refined and subtle palate. Bracing acidity with mineral notes, green orchard fruits and just a hint of lemon pith on the finish.

Château Favray Pouilly Fumé - France (8) £42

Floral and fruity bouquet with crisp, citrus fruit, great length and piercing tones of limestone minerality. Round, lush and utterly elegant.

Vignobles Dubard Coeur du Mont Sauvignon Blanc - France (11) £32

On the nose, this white wine combines gooseberry, exotic fruit and peach. The palate is rich and generous, with a fresh, tasty finish and a fruity after-tast

Seachange Viognier - France - Languedoc (9) £28

expressive and aromatic with a rich, round structure. This wine is fruit driven with a little grapefruit zest. Golden in colour with lots of citrus, apricot and lychee notes

Weingut Tesch Riesling Queen of Whites - Germany (10) £32

Queen's pawn to lemon and lime and rook to king's minerals and oranges. Knights lead oranges and acacia flowers into a flavour battle with tasty stone fruits. Think you know German Riesling? Think again. Check mate.

Quinta da Lixa Flowers Vinho Verde - Portugal (5) £25

Fruity, floral notes, a slight fizz, fresh and well balanced. The nose is aromatic green apple, melon and white peach.

Alba Martin Albarino - Spain (4) £33

Vivid straw-yellow green colour. Bright and shiny. Intense nose and elegant aromas with hints of white stone fruits and white flowers. The wine is rounded and full-bodied, with a light persistence that adds to its vivacious sense of freshness.

Reds

Trapiche Estación 1883 Cabernet Franc - Argentina (29) £35

Herbal, floral, forest fruit aromas. Palate is vibrant with darker fruit and spicy notes at the fore, developing to a lingering rich finish with hints of coffee.

Don David Malbec Reserve Argentina (25) £35

Medium-full bodied and aromatic, with notes of cooked plums, prunes and violets. Hints of spicy paprika balance with the sweet tannins and round off in a smooth finish.

Ventopuro Estelar Carmenere - Chile (27) £34

Dark cherry, plum, and bramble fruit explode like a supernova from the nose before an entire galaxy's worth of smoke, vanilla, cedar, and warm spices flood the senses. Big, rich, and characterful; it's a true reflection of just how good Carmenere can be.

Les Mougeottes Pinot Noir IGP P d'Oc - France (17) £27

The darker, richer side of Pinot Noir. With enough ripeness, the Noir can give dark cherry and plum characters as well as some violet notes. This has a splash of fresh vanilla smoke to add an extra frissant to proceedings.

Château St Marie Bordeaux - France (18) £34

Beautifully vibrant, just-picked berry fruit aromas and flavours, with a hint of aromatic spice and vanilla, that gives it a definite Bordeaux sense of place. Clean, refreshing and oh so silky smooth.

Brotte Cotes Du Rhone - France (28) £30

A supple spice driven Rhone. Red fruits and cherries are surrounded by sweet smoke, pepper and thyme. Soft, integrated tannins add a touch of complexity.

Château Bel-Air Puisseguin St Emilion - France - Bordeaux (30) £42

The nose is redolent with plums, damsons, dark cherry, and a healthy wallop of blackcurrant fruit.

Joseph Drouhin Givry 2019 - France - Burgundy (34)l £60

Drouhin makes a taut and precise style of wine that always has a certain generosity. Here ripe cherries, wild strawberries and forest fruits are to the fore, there's a hint of something earthy and minerally but it's downplayed to allow the fruit to shine

Reds continued...

Da Vinci Chianti Riserva - Italy - Tuscany (16) £38
Quintessential Chianti, a blend of cherries and loamy earth, prettily perfumed by violets.

Posidone Primitivo Salento - Italy (23) £27
Posidone Organic Primitivo is a red wine from Italy's Puglia region, accompanied by hints of spice, licorice and earthy undertones. Its full-bodied nature is complemented by velvety tannins and a balanced acidity, creating a smooth yet powerful profile.

Reserva Collector is a powerful and earthy 5 year old blend port. Firm and full of blackberry fruits on the palate with silky tannins. Awarded Silver Medal at Decanter World Wine Awards 2006.

Quinta Do Crasto 2017 Vintage Port - Portugal (47) £70
Excellent aroma expression and concentration, showing fresh berry fruit and soft hints of spice.
